Swim Season is Just Around the Corner!

We are excited that summer is nearly here...and we are waiting for that pool to open. We hope your children will join us.

About Carefree Crocodiles...(info to share with your children's friends!)

The Carefree Crocodiles Swim Team is a recreational program offering children ages 5-17 from Greenwood and surrounding communities an opportunity "get their feet wet" with a splash of competitive swimming. Our team members practice 55 minutes four times a week beginning at either 7:30 or 8:25 a.m. During practices, our coaching staff provides instruction on proper stroke technique, starts, turns, and other components necessary to compete in meets. Please note that the Swim Team is **not** a "Learn to Swim" or swim lesson experience. While it is not a requirement for team members to know all the strokes or to have perfect technique, they must be able to swim comfortably in deep water.

We are members of the Community Swim Conference, and swim against four other conference teams from the surrounding Indianapolis area in dual meets. At the end of the season, a conference meet is held with all five teams participating. The dual meets, usually 2 to 2 1/2 hours long, are scheduled in the evenings beginning June 15 and the conference meet is scheduled for July 24 at the University of Indianapolis. A Swim Meet and Event Schedule is attached for your information.

Registration, Meet Volunteer Sheet, and Fees...

Registration forms for your children who participated previously as a Carefree Crocodile and a fee schedule are included with this letter. Please feel free to make copies if you have other children or friends who are interested in swimming with us this year.

PLEASE NOTE...In order to provide a quality swim team experience for each child, we will limit our team size to **130 swimmers** this year. First preference will be given to those children who have been a member of our team in past years. In order to guarantee your child's spot on the team, we strongly encourage you to **submit your registration by Wednesday, May 5**, the night of our registration for swim team and swim lessons. After May 5th, we will open up registration to new families and the team will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

Your registration fee includes a tee shirt. Team swim suits are available will be ordered during both practice sessions on a day during the week of June 7 (actual date will be confirmed shortly). Please bring a checkbook if you plan on ordering a team suit. Swim caps will also be available for sale.

Each family is required to work three meets. On the last page, the various positions are described, as well as the number needed for each meet. As you can see, we need many volunteers to run our home meets, as well as work at away meets to help the host team. All volunteer sign-ups will be done electronically through our website. Sign-up for meets by going to www.carefreecrocodiles.org and clicking on the "Meet Volunteers - Sign-Up" link on the home page.

As with most things in life, the registration fees alone do not cover our total operating expenses. This year, the Carefree Crocodiles will host their 15th Annual Crocodile Fun Run. As our main fundraiser, this year's event will take place on Saturday, July 10th. It is a 5K run/walk and a 1-mile family walk around the Carefree subdivision. The race is open to everyone. Working at and/or participating in the Fun Run is a Swim Team requirement. Please contact Erich Bauer at 888-4191, if you can help out with pre-race planning. Volunteer sign-up sheets will also be available at registration and the Parents' Meeting.

Who's running the show?

A board of parent volunteers governs the Carefree Crocodiles Swim Team. We meet regularly to attend to the needs of the Swim Team and work closely with the volunteer board of Carefree Club, Inc.

We are very pleased to announce that three members of our coaching staff will be returning this year. **Sam Robertson** will continue as our head coach. She brings many years of coaching experience and enthusiasm to the Crocodiles. This will be her sixth year coaching with Carefree and we are delighted to have her back.

Joining Sam as assistant coaches will be:

- **Marcie Colwell.** Marcie will also be returning as an assistant coach to our 9-10 year old swimmers. Marcie has been an assistant coach with the Indy Dolphins for many years and does a great job on strengthening her swimmer's ability. We are excited to have her back with us.
- **Holly Reed.** Holly returns to us in her new position as an assistant coach to our 8 & under swimmers. Holly had been our technique coach for two seasons, and we look forward to having her move up to an assistant coach. Please welcome her in her new coaching position.

Depending on the number of swimmers in each age group, there may be some shifting to even out the number of swimmers per coach.

And now for that Parents' Meeting...

Please plan to join us for the annual Parents' Meeting scheduled for **Friday, June 4th, beginning at 8:30 a.m.** in the picnic area of the pool deck. We will review the meet and event schedule, sign up volunteers for meets, discuss the intra-squad meet, review Fun Run plans and update you on other pertinent issues. If you are unable to attend, please contact any board member for details.

Swim Meet Job Descriptions

TIMER: Each lane has 2 timers, 1 from the home team and 1 from the visiting team. Stopwatches are provided. 6 timers needed for each home meet. Either 4 or 6 timers needed for away meets (depends on number of lanes).

WRITER: Each lane has one writer who records the swimmer's name, event and times. Clipboards and forms are provided. 2-3 writers needed for each home and away meet (depends on number of lanes).

RUNNER: At the completion of each event, a runner picks up the forms from each writer and delivers them to the scoring table. 3 runners needed for each home meet.

FINISH JUDGE: Each team provides a finish judge who sits at the end of the pool and records the order of swimmers' finish by lane. Clipboard and forms provided. 1 judge needed for each home and away meet.

RIBBON WRITER: Seated at the scoring table, these writers record the names and times of the winning swimmers on the back of the ribbons. 3 ribbon writers needed for each home and away meet.

SCORER: Based on the results of each event, the scorer awards points to the appropriate team. Special training will be provided for this position. 1 scorer needed for each home and away meet.

ANNOUNCER: Using a public address system, the announcer informs the swimmers of each event and makes other general announcements. 1 announcer needed for each home meet.

STARTER: The starter calls the swimmers to their positions and begins the race with a starting gun. Special training will be provided for this position. 1 starter needed for each home meet.

STROKE JUDGE: Each team provides an individual who monitors the quality of the swimmers' strokes during the race. The stroke judge can disqualify a swimmer if they do not meet the specific requirements of each stroke. Stroke judging guidelines are provided along with special training. 1 stroke judge needed for each home and away meet.

CONCESSION WORKER: During home meets we operate a concession stand. Volunteers purchase food items to sell and do basic food preparation. They man the stand during the meet. 6 volunteers needed for each home meet - 4 to cover the first half of the meet, 4 to cover the second half of the meet.

KIDS' COORDINATOR: These individuals assist the coaches in getting swimmers organized for their events and general "crowd control". 2 volunteers needed for each home and away meet.

FIRST AID: This volunteer handles any emergencies that may arise. Medical training required. 1 volunteer needed for each home and away meet.

CLEAN-UP COORDINATOR: The good news about this job is that you only have to work about 15 minutes AFTER the meet! This volunteer coordinates the trash pick-up done by the swimmers and works with our Meet Manager to ensure the pool area is in good order at the end of the meet. 1 volunteer needed for each home meet.

MARSHAL: This volunteer circulates in the pool and surrounding areas, including restrooms, to ensure that pool safety rules are being followed. 1 volunteer needed for each home meet.
